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**OFFICIAL NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS OF DISTRICT 1199C**

**Notice of election and  
availability of nominating petitions**

In accordance with the By-Laws of District 1199C, Articles X and XI and the AFSCME Election Code, Appendix D of the International Constitution, members are hereby notified that the District elections for officers, executive board members, and delegates will be held on Tuesday and Wednesday, May 7 and 8, 2019 with balloting to take place from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm or at times designated by the Elections and Objections Committee. The offices to be elected include the following: president, secretary-treasurer, executive vice-presidents, vice president of the Hospital Division, executive board representing all executive board areas, and delegates representing all departments and classifications in all institutions.

Nominating petitions will be available on Tuesday, February 19, 2019, and must be returned by Thursday, March 21, 2019. Detailed notices will be posted in all institutions with collective bargaining agreements with District 1199C no later than Thursday, April 18, 2019. These notices will provide the names of the candidates for officers and executive board, the delegate slots to be filled and the people running for them, and notification of the hours and locations of polling.

In order to be nominated for the position of president, secretary-treasurer or executive vice-president, a member must obtain on an official nominating petition the signatures of 210 members in good standing (2% of the membership of the District), including at least 153 signatures from the Hospital Division and 57 signatures from the Guild Division.

In order to be nominated for the position of vice-president of the Hospital Division, a member must obtain on an official nominating petition(s) the signatures of at least 153 signatures from the Hospital Division.

*United We Care*

In order to be nominated for the position of member of the Executive Board, a member must obtain on an official nominating petition(s) the signatures of at least 20 members in good standing from an institution or institutions in the Division Area from which the candidate seeks election.

In order to be nominated for the position of Delegate, a member must obtain on an official nominating petition(s) the signatures of no less than two (2) members in good standing from among the membership of the department and/or classification and shift, where applicable, from which the candidate seeks election.

To be eligible, a candidate for office must be a member in good standing for a minimum of one year. This requirement is waived for candidates for delegate at newly organized institutions. In addition, the AFSCME Election Code has additional eligibility criteria. The District 1199C By-Laws, the AFSCME Election Code and the Rules for the Conduct of the 2019 District 1199C Elections and Executive Board areas are posted on the Union's website, [www.1199cnuhhce.org](http://www.1199cnuhhce.org).

Good standing shall mean that a member is not in arrears in the payment of dues, initiation fees or fines and assessments, if any, or any other indebtedness to the District or to the National Union. Whenever a member authorizes an Employer to check of his dues and/or initiation fee pursuant to a collective bargaining agreement and the employer complies with such authorization, the member shall be considered in good standing.
